The Cirque Jules Verne School

The Cirque Jules Verne School, strong in its history and its place in a National Circus Pole, has developed its identity and its uniqueness in the landscape of Circus Arts teaching in France. Preparatory training

From September 2022, the preparatory training is **recognized by the University of Artois**. This all new partnership gives rise to a new offer:

- · Validation of 120 ECTS
- Possibility of integrating the License 3 of Performing Arts of Arras at the end of the preparatory training
- · Possibility of obtaining equivalences in other faculties
- Students in preparatory training benefit from student status, which entitles them to CROUS services (housing, university restaurants, discounts on public transports, etc.).

Tremplin training is a training offering the possibility to young people, European or extra-community, having a circus background or coming from neighboring artistic branches (dance, fine arts, dramatic art, etc.) wishing to integrate a course of excellence to meet the prerequisites of preparatory schools and artistic training requiring auditions.

This year of training allows future candidates to:

- · refine their training project
- · gradually adapt to the pace required in preparatory and higher school
- · strengthen themselves physically
- · approach artistic research
- · discover circus specialties
